

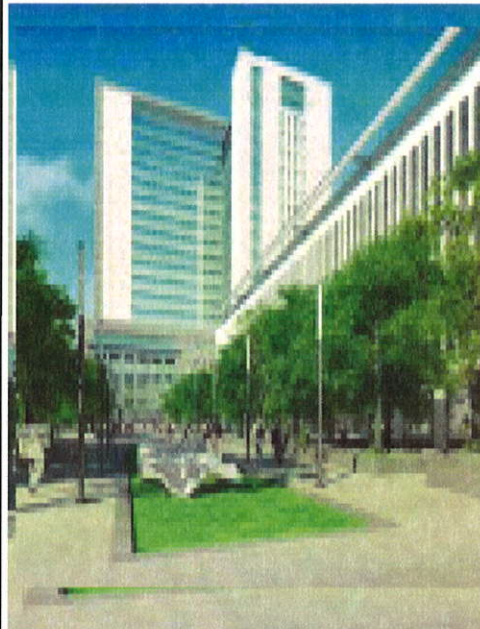


Electronic Court Records

Broward County

Effective April 7, 2014

A new website service for Broward County titled
Electronic Court Records



allows free access to electronic case records via the Court's wireless (Wi-Fi) access points at all four Broward Courthouse locations. Attorneys, agency personnel and interested parties may search and view case details and electronic document images attached to a case, by using their own devices, while in court.

- The web service is geared toward use by laptops using the following browsers:

Internet Explorer,
Mozilla Firefox and
Safari.

- Other portable devices may be able to connect, but viewing may be limited by the device's display capability.
- Document images may not be downloaded or printed.

Please note a few variables that may impact the ability to access case records:

- The Website may not be compatible with all possible portable devices or web browsers.
- Wi-Fi coverage may not be available in certain areas of the Courthouse.
- Guidelines for use of laptops and portable devices in the courtrooms are at the discretion of the Judge.

Directions to connect:

1. Connect your device to wireless network **"Courthouse Public Wi-Fi"**.
2. Enter <http://ecr.browardclerk.info> in your browser and accept website disclaimer to continue.
3. Search by party name, case number and other search criteria available, depending on case type.
